Watercolor Exhibition at Erin's Restaurant

Throughout the month of June, watercolors by three members of the Catawba River Art Guild—Madie Horne, Anna McAteer, and Herb Dumaresq—are on exhibit at Erin's Restaurant.

Madie Horne is president of the Catawba River Art Guild, a membership-based collective of local artists. Horne was interested in art as a child, but she did not begin to pursue it until she became an adult. It was then that she participated in art workshops; and took drawing and painting classes. Horne created art with oils or pastels until realizing that watercolors were her true passion. Most of her paintings on display are scenes from Uruguay, South America, where she lived before moving to Rock Hill.

Anna McAteer began painting with watercolors four

years ago, after retiring from a 40-year career in corporate human resources. She studied drawing, perspective, and watercolor theory under Johnny Wine of York and, later, under Terry Harrison of London, England. Several of McAteer's watercolor paintings display an emotional connection to landscapes, old homes, barns, doorways, and storefronts. Others depict her passion for water reflections.

Also on display are watercolors by Herb Dumaresq, vice-president of the Catawba River Art Guild. All works in this watercolor exhibition may be viewed during Erin's Restaurant's regular business hours: Monday—Friday, 11am to 2:30pm; Tuesday—Thursday, 5pm to 9pm; Friday—Saturday, 5pm to 10pm; and Sunday, 10:30am to 2pm.
