Old Town Farmers Market On Expanded Ag + Art Tour

For the third consecutive year, Old Town Farmers Market will be part of the Ag + Art Tour. While the tour only covered York and Lancaster Counties in the past, it has been expanded this year to include Chester and Fairfield Counties as well.

The Ag + Art Tour is a free, self-guided tour of the Catawba Region’s farms and farmers markets, featuring local artisans and musicians along the way.

The 2014 Ag + Art Tour will be held on **June 21st** from 9am to 5pm and **June 22nd** from 1pm to 5pm. It is the

largest free farm tour in the nation!

During this event, visit local farms and watch artisans in action. Several Old Town Farmers Market vendors will be participating in this tour: The Pennell Barn, Tirzah Farm and Flowers, Rockin’ Rags, Fishing Creek Creamery, Windy Hill Orchard and Cidery, and Sally’s Handwovens.

In York County, at Hill Mercantile in Sharon, tour participants can also view “From Barns to Bedcovers,” a quilt and art show made possible by the York County Quilters Guild and the Yorkville Artists Guild.

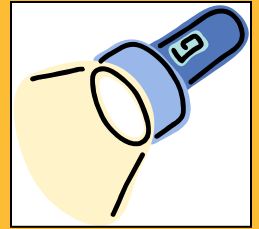
